This international scientific-practical conference, organized by the Union of restorers of the Republic of Lithuania, is intended not only to review the work carried out over three decades of operation, but also to reveal to the public and professionals the immensity of preserved cultural heritage sites; critically evaluate the preservation methods that have been used; to acquire and share new knowledge, methods, and peculiarities of application of technologies; get acquainted with good practices; engage the public in further discussion and collaboration.

Restorers, architects, architectural historians, art critics, cultural heritage professionals and the laypersons interested in heritage are invited to participate in this international scientific-practical conference. The two-day event will feature presentations on current and future issues of heritage management, conservation and preservation. Discussions will continue at restored and ongoing restoration sites.

**Expected conference session thematic groups:**

1. Immovable cultural heritage (cultural landscape and urban environment, architectural heritage, interior, etc.)
2. Movable cultural heritage (painting, sculpture, furniture, written heritage, etc.)
3. Heritage and communities

**The abstracts of the presentation should be submitted in Lithuanian or English:**

- a) The abstract of the paper shall be limited to 2500 characters;
- b) CV and academic resume / portfolio of the scientific/practical activity;
- c) All contact information (including email).

Presentation time is limited to 20 minutes plus discussion time (10 minutes). The conference languages are Lithuanian and English.

- Notice of accepted applications will be announced by 15<sup>th</sup> of May, 2021.
- Simultaneous translation is provided at the conference, therefore the final paper should be sent by 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2020.
